Internet for IPDPS Attendees: IPDPS will provide 24-hour Internet access all week, free of charge, in three designated areas of the Palazzo Carpegna hotel: 1) wireless in restaurant foyer, 2) wireless in library/business center, and 3) wired in the Pio XI room near Registration. (Italy requires a unique Internet access id to be assigned to all attendees.) In addition, the Palazzo Carpegna commercial wireless provider (Quadriga) provides access anywhere in the hotel, including conference rooms & guest rooms, and attendees may register for 3 days at a charge of 25 euros.

Lunch On-your-own: The lunch break is two hours, so you will have time to enjoy the Aurelia park setting outside the hotels. IPDPS has arranged with several nearby cafes to provide luncheon specials to IPDPS Attendees, plus there are many "fast food" spots in the area. For more formal lunch, the Palazzo Carpegna restaurant will offer IPDPS attendees a special price of 25 euros for a served lunch (make reservations by 10:00 AM to assure seating).
