Application for Student Travel Assistance Grant

IEEE 23rd International Parallel & Distributed Processing Symposium IPDPS 2009 • May 25-29, 2009 • Aurelia Convention Centre & Expo • Rome, Italy

A limited number of travel assistance grants are available from the IPDPS sponsor TCPP. Priority will be given to students who would otherwise be unable to attend the conference and to graduate students presenting their own published work. Notice of awards will be made prior to the conference. The grants will be distributed post-conference in the form of reimbursements against actual travel and accommodations expenses submitted by the student. The amount of the grants will be based in part on student travel requirements, quality of paper/poster, and on TCPP funds availability. To qualify for a student travel assistance grant, a recipient must be:

- an author of an accepted conference, TCPP PhD forum, or workshop paper and be registered for the conference,
- a Student Member of IEEE Computer Society at the time he/she submits an application, and
- a full-time student regularly registered toward a degree in computer science, engineering or related field at a university.

To apply for a grant, complete the information in the form below and obtain your advisor's signature endorsing your application and confirming your need for travel expense support.
