

## Technical Committee on Parallel Processing (TCPP) Application for Student Travel Assistance Grant

## IEEE 24th International Parallel & Distributed Processing Symposium IPDPS 2010 • April 19-23 • Downtown Sheraton • Atlanta, Georgia USA

A limited number of travel assistance grants are available from the IPDPS sponsor TCPP. Priority will be given to students who would otherwise be unable to attend the conference and to graduate students presenting their own published work. Notice of awards will be made prior to the conference. The grants will be distributed post-conference in the form of reimbursements against actual travel, registration and accommodations expenses submitted by the student. The amount of the grants will be based in part on student travel requirements, quality of paper/poster, and on TCPP funds availability. To qualify for a student travel assistance grant, a recipient must be:

- an author of an accepted conference, PhD forum, or workshop paper and be registered for the conference,
- a Student Member of IEEE Computer Society at the time he/she submits an application, and
- a full-time student regularly registered toward a degree in computer science, engineering or related field at a university.

To apply for a grant, complete the information in the form below and obtain your advisor's endorsement & signature. The **completed application form along with your paper-poster acceptance notice and all reviews** should be <u>submitted as a single pdf or zip file</u>, attached to an email with subject: <u>your full name – TCPP/IPDPS 2010 Travel</u> <u>Application</u>. The body of the email should include: your name, contact information, and title of paper/poster. Send this email with the single pdf or zip file attached to **travelgrant@ipdps.org**. The file name of the attachment should contain your name. Applications should be **submitted by February 15, 2010**. Notification of awards will be made by the end of February.
