Application for Student Travel Assistance Grant

IEEE 27th International Parallel & Distributed Processing Symposium IPDPS 2013 • May 20-24 • Hyatt Regency Cambridge • Boston, MA - USA

A limited number of travel assistance grants are available from the IPDPS sponsor TCPP. Priority will be given to students -based on merit- who would otherwise be unable to attend the conference and to graduate students presenting their own published work. Notice of awards will be made prior to the conference. The grants will be distributed post-conference in the form of reimbursements against actual travel, registration and accommodations expenses submitted by the student. The amount of the grants will be based in part on student travel requirements, quality of paper/poster, and on TCPP funds availability. To qualify for a student travel assistance grant, a recipient must be:

- an author of an accepted conference, PhD forum, or workshop paper and be registered for the conference,
- a Student Member of IEEE Computer Society at the time he/she submits an application, and
- a full-time student regularly registered toward a degree in computer science, engineering or related field at a university.

To apply for a grant, complete the information in the form below and obtain your advisor's endorsement & signature. The completed application form along with your paper-poster acceptance notice AND all reviews should be submitted as a single pdf file at the EasyChair submission portal for IPDPS2013-Student-Travel. Use the link to EasyChair on the IPDPS Web Student Travel page. The pdf file name of the attachment should contain your full name. Applications should be submitted by March 15, 2013. Notification of awards will be made in late March.
